RURAL ROADS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT III (RRIP III)

INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST CONSULTING SERVICES FOR IMPLEMENTATION

The Government is expected to receive the loan/grant from Asian Development Bank (ADB) for the Rural Roads Improvement Project III. Part of the loan proceeds will be applied for eligible payments under the civil works and consulting services contracts under the Project.

The project will rehabilitate about 360 kilometers (km) of rural roads with DBST pavement in five provinces (Kampong Cham, Tboung Khmum, Prey Veng, Svay Rieng and Kratie).

The Ministry of Rural Development (MRD) will be the executing agency for the Project. MRD will be responsible for selecting consulting services and awarding civil works contracts. The civil works comprise the improvement of existing earth or gravel surfaced roads to a bitumen sealed standard using a double bituminous surface treatment (DBST), including placement as necessary of sub-base and road base, using unbound materials. The works do not permit widening of the existing road structure. The works also involves replacement or repair of existing cross drainage and the placement of some new culverts. It also involves repair replacement of small bridges at existing locations. Bridges that are replaced will be widened. The works also include a series of capacity building components including support to the MRD and SEO (Social and Environment Office).

The Consultant will be responsible for the design and supervision of 6 civil works packages CW-A, CW-B1, CW-B2, CW-C, CW-D and CW-E which are financed by ADB. The consultant will also be responsible for environmental and social safeguards measures.

The MRD now invites interested consultants, who is suitably qualified and experienced, to express their interests in providing these services and to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) for the said consulting service. The consultant selection will be quality and cost based selection method (QCBS) as described in the ADB Guideline on the Use of Consultants by Asian Development Bank and Its Borrowers, published in March 2013. The short listing evaluation will be based on the EOI-form that the interested consultants must use to submit the expression of interest.

Expression of Interest must be submitted to ADB CMS website on or before 25 July 2018. Off-line submission will be rejected. The inquiries on the EOI can be contacted to address below.
